About Smith Island

Smith Island, the largest remaining inhabited island in the Chesapeake, consists of three separate towns—each with its won picturesque setting—and the 4,000-acre Martin National Wildlife Conservatory.

Discovered by Captain John Smith in 1608, and settled by English and Welsh settlers in 1659, today's inhabitants can trace their genealogy back 12 generations.



The island's isolation has helped to preserve the old English / Welsh culture and dialect of its founders.



A visit to Smith Island is like returning to a time when people lived in villages built with charm and shared their skills and talents to help one another. Each rustic village has a working harbor where islanders—on locally-built boats—earn a living from crabbing and oystering.

Plenty to See, Plenty to Do

Smith Island is a restful place, but there is still plenty to see and do. If you walk around the harbor town and take the time to meet the people of Smith Island, you will find out what it is that makes Smith Island such an attractive place to live.



You may choose to do little more than relax in our boathouse or along our private dock where you can take in the sights and sounds of the harbor—the birds and wildlife, the passing boats, the watermen at work.

For the more adventurous sort, we have kayaks you can take out into the Bay. Or you can take a bike tour of Ewell or the nearby village of Rhodes Point. You are welcome to bring your own bikes or boats, but we have a limited number of bikes



and kayaks available at no extra cost to our guests.



Catch fish from the pier, or let us show you how to drop a crab pot.

You can order a bushel of crabs and take a sunset cruise around the island. Chartered fishing tours led by an experienced guide are also available. Inquire about rates. Request in advance.

Also available are guided tours of the nature preserve, or for bird-watching and arrowhead hunting.
